### ROGERS COMMUNICATIONS & FIDO SOLUTIONS

#### Roger and Fido International MMS Settlement

This notice concerns a **class action** authorized on **January 22, 2015** by the Court of Appeal of Québec against **Rogers Communications** and **Fido Solutions** on behalf of a class of persons comprising the group described hereinbelow:

*“All Persons residing in Quebec who had a fixed term wireless services contract with Rogers Communications Inc. or Fido Solutions Inc. in effect as of August 15, 2011 and who received a notice concerning new fees applicable to international video and/or photo messaging (MMS) sent from Canada to an international destination.”*

**Mrs. Amram** has been granted the status of representative of the above Class (group) for the purpose of instituting a class action.

#### Excluding Yourself from the Class Action

Detailed notices to Class Members with respect to this action, including the formalities required to be followed with respect to the right of exclusion (also called an Opt-Out) by which a Class Member may exclude themselves from the Class, are available from Class Counsel at address provided below. If you exclude yourself from the Class, you **cannot** receive money or any other compensation from the proposed settlement, if it is approved, and you **cannot** object to the proposed settlement.

#### The Settlement of the Class Action

A proposed settlement has been reached with respect to the class action mentioned above whereby Rogers and Fido have agreed without admission of fault to reimburse **all** the amounts of international MMS fees collected from Class Members who had either a Rogers or Fido fixed-term wireless services contract in effect as of August 15, 2011 and who paid for international MMS fees during the term of that fixed-term contract.

#### Making a Claim for Compensation Under the Settlement

If you wish to receive the financial benefits of the settlement and you **are still a customer of Rogers or Fido**, you do not have to take any action. You will be compensated automatically in the form of an automatic credit on a forthcoming invoice.

If you are **no longer a customer of Rogers or Fido**, no direct compensation will be provided, but these class members will be compensated indirectly through charitable donations by the Defendants in the total amount of \$151,109.50 made 50% to la Fondation UQTR and 50% to le Fonds de développement ÉTS, which represents 100% of the settlement amount attributable to the claims of these members (former Rogers or Fido customers).

### **Objecting to the Settlement**

If you wish to object to or submit comments regarding the proposed settlement, you **must** send your written objection or comments to the Clerk of the Quebec Superior Court by no later than **July 5, 2020**. Your written objection **MUST** include (a) your name, address, e-mail address and telephone number; (b) a brief statement of the reasons for your objection; and (c) whether you plan to attend at the hearing in person or through a lawyer, and if by lawyer, the name, address, e-mail address and telephone number of the lawyer. You **cannot** object to the settlement if you exclude yourself (opt-out) from the class action. You may also attend at the settlement approval hearing itself which will take place at the **Quebec Superior Court, 1 Notre Dame Street East, Montréal, Québec on, July 7, 2020 at 9:00 AM, in room 16.61**.

If you are a Class Member and do not object to the Settlement Agreement, you do NOT have to do anything and you do NOT have to attend the Approval Hearing.

In case of any discrepancy between this abridged notice and the detailed notices, the terms of the detailed notice shall prevail (a copy of which is available from Class Counsel at the address below).
